

WELCOME to our 49th Annual SPRING Jewels to Junk Antiques & Collectibles Street Fair Sunday, May 17TH, 2015

PLEASE READ ALL INFORMATION BELOW

We are again requiring a refundable \$50 cleaning deposit to be sent by separate check with your application. <u>Please send two</u> (2) self addressed stamped envelopes. One for the confirmation map and one for your cleaning deposit, which will be returned the week following this event. You will not be invited back if you have left boxes, paper and general trash behind. We will have 'BLOCK CAPTAINS" to check your space before you leave. For those vendors from the fall event who left a clean space, thank you. For those who didn't, and there were many, we felt we needed to maintain the cleaning deposit program. It's impossible for our small volunteer group to clean up after so many.

VENDOR PARKING IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. DO NOT PARK YOUR VEHICLES ON THE STREET. YOU WILL BE TOWED. CHECK YOUR CONFIRMATION MAP FOR VENDOR PARKING ONLY...

We are continuing our policy of NO NEW MERCHANDISE, including crafts, new imported buy and sell items and new costume jewelry, which result from watching other major fairs deteriorate because newly-manufactured items were introduced. We do however, accept "Shabby Chic" and "repurposed" items on a limited basis. If your application states either of these themes, the committee will call you to make sure you are not in a "crafts" category. The exception to this policy is that those Old Town merchants who are not antique dealers may sell in their booth, items carried in their stores. By signing the application, you are agreeing to the conditions and restrictions. Be sure to sign your application. You must be ready and set up for business no later than 8am. If you arrive late, you will not be allowed to set up. Stay within your own 10x10' space and make sure your neighbor has enough room to set up a full space. I ROLLED BACK THE SPACE FEE TO \$65 several years ago to help make the fee more affordable for all.

MANY VENDOR'S HAVE BEEN ENCROACHING FAR BEYOND THEIR 10'X10' SPACES. BE VERY SURE YOU

CAN FIT ALL OF YOUR ITEMS INTO THIS SPACE SIZE, OTHERWISE, YOU WILL BE CHARGED AN

ADDITIONAL FEE THE DAY OF THE EVENT. ALL BOUNDARIES ARE CLEARLY MARKED

Please remember the following when filling out your application:

- 1. Carefully read the ENTIRE application/contract.
- 2. Fill out the form completely. Be sure to check the boxes "merchandise to be sold" and describe what you'll be selling. Be certain your <u>RESALE NUMBER</u> is included, and your phone number in case we need to reach you.
- 3. Include 2 (#10) LARGE STAMPED, self-addressed envelopes so your acceptance and cleaning/guarantee deposit can be returned to you. <u>To keep event expenses manageable, be sure to include the stamped envelopes. Your deposit check will be shredded if there is no envelope for its return. BE SURE TO SIGN YOUR APPLICATION</u>
- 4. Keep track of the APRIL 1ST DEADLINE. This applies to all vendors.

PLEASE NOTE: Sidewalks and walkways into shops must be kept open for buyer and emergency access and must not be blocked with boxes, merchandise or chairs. You will be asked to move them.

You must pack up your booth first before you'll be allowed to bring in your car at 4pm. Volunteers at the barricades will direct traffic at this time. BLOCK CAPTAINS WILL CHECK TO MAKE SURE YOU ARE PACKED UP first. Be courteous and patient. If you leave prior to 4pm, leave your space with trash or you are a "no show", you will forfeit your deposit. Be courteous to fellow vendors and do not start to pack up your space before 4pm.

Coordinating the street fair is a tremendous job performed by our merchants volunteering time while also running their businesses.
